1	Do you sign a Data Privacy Agreement?	Yes. We sign the National Data Privacy Agreement (NDPA) or your district's standard DPA.	PART K, SCHEDULE B
2	What student data do you collect?	In default Zero-Roster Mode: none — families self-enter contact info and self-select teachers. In opt-in Invitation Mode: only the family contact list the school uploads, used solely to send invitations.	SCHEDULE B; I-2
3	Where is student data stored?	Invitation Mode data lives only in SchoolConferenceGo's own database — never in central systems, never commingled with other products.	G-1
4	Do you sell data or use it for advertising?	Never. No data sales, no advertising profiles, no ads to families, no third-party ad trackers.	K-3 §2; G-4
5	Do students or parents create accounts?	No. Parents book without accounts; students never interact. Only school staff hold accounts.	G-1
6	How is data secured?	Encryption in transit, role-based access, signature-verified integrations, Stripe-hosted payments only, rate-limited public endpoints, secrets never in code.	G-2, G-3
7	Subprocessors?	Stripe, Clerk (staff auth only), Resend, Mobile Text Alerts, RavenDB Cloud and hosting. Current list at /privacy.	K-3 §4
8	Data retention and deletion?	Retained while the account exists (read-only if lapsed); deletion within 30 days of request; export anytime in open formats.	G-5; K-1 §4
9	Breach notification?	Prompt disclosure to org owners for any incident affecting your data; NDPA timelines honored where signed.	K-3 §8; F-6
10	FERPA compliance posture?	Zero-Roster avoids FERPA disclosure by design; Invitation Mode under the school-official exception with a DPA. State student-privacy laws honored where we serve.	SCHEDULE B
11	COPPA?	Not applicable by design: services directed to adults; no under-18 accounts; no information collected from children.	K-3 §7
12	Insurance / W-9 / vendor forms?	Provided on request.	J-5
